	Employment	People achieve positive employment outcomes over time, supported by relevant services. People are assisted to set up small businesses.	<i>Finding a job and earning an income.</i>
	Health and wellbeing	People experience positive health and wellbeing and participate in health and wellbeing programs and services.	<i>Seeking medical care and assistance.</i>
	Education and training	Adults and children access and participate in high quality education, training and skills development. Adults can get their overseas education, training, skills and experience recognised.	<i>Enrolling children in school, working on English skills and getting overseas skills recognised.</i>
	Language services	People access high-quality translating and interpreting services, and a wide range of translated resources.	<i>Using an interpreter and accessing information in my language.</i>
	Family and social supports	People establish and maintain safe, healthy, positive and meaningful family and social relationships supported by relevant services.	<i>Seeking family and social supports, like joining a sporting club.</i>
	Justice	People access legal and justice systems and are supported to understand their rights and responsibilities in Australia.	<i>Seeking legal advice.</i>
	Civic participation	People participate in Australian society and democratic processes and exercise their rights and responsibilities under the law.	<i>Building understanding about citizenship.</i>
	Transport	People access affordable transport options including public and private transport and driving licenses.	<i>Getting NSW drivers license.</i>
	Finance	People confidently navigate their finances and are supported to make good financial decisions.	<i>Building financial independence.</i>
