Change needed to inspections

1. An inspection can be conducted after 3 months of moving into a property

This is unfair to a tenant having gone through a move (which is high on the stress level indicator, costly and exhausting)

- 2. Being able to inspect 4 times a year is not fair and is contradictory to "peace and quiet" as required 're Tenancy Act/lease agreement
- 3. There appears to be no coverage of an Agent or owner inspecting a property that they are not allowed to open cupboard doors which contain a tenants possessions. If no notice has been given by the tenant that a repair is needed in the cupboard why is this not stated in the lease/residential tenancy act that this is not permissible?? This is an invasion of privacy
- 4. Photographs are taken at inspections

This should not be permissable

Only photos of repairs needed should be permissable
These photos contain the tenants posessions - privacy?

In the good old days a tenant paid their rent and was left alone and was not subjected to constant intrusive "inspections". This gave a sense of "ownership

5. A more minor issue is not being able to hang paintings etc. Perhaps if hooks were on the walls as a fixture of a property this allows a tenant to enjoy the outcome of their use

I hope to hear back on my feedback etc

It is the aim of some tenants that we will be advocating for Change in the Residentail Tenancy Act
