Submission

- 1. Residents who live in a complex but do not own their own car space must be allowed to share visitor's parking with visitors. Otherwise, they are not allowed to park where they live.
 - a. If they park on the street it adds to congestion.
 - b. Visitors do not make a contribution towards the upkeep, but residents do.
- 2. The owner's Corporation must be contactable directly and should report to all owners and renters on meetings and decisions made.
 - a. Renters must be able to approach the owner's corporation directly to appeal for a decision to be made.
- 3. All owners and renter must be given the direct contact details of the owners' corporation without having to go through the building managers.
- 4. Renters should have some representation on the owner's corporation and that representative must be a renter and their direct contact details given to all renters. Without representation, renters are subjected to a level of government without any representation. This is not democratic.
